It would be hypocritical to point a finger at the unflattering picture of the Pharisees painted in the gospel. What Jesus is saying is important to us too. Very few can truthfully say that our deeds always match our words. We easily put on a show to hide our short comings and appear virtuous by presenting one face for the public and displaying a different one for our own family and friends. While Christ hated hypocrisy in all forms, sincerity and openness of character appealed to him. He could gaze into the depths of the person's heart. He wanted his disciples to avoid such attitudes which emptied God's word of its power.

The gospel of Mathew 23:1-12 ie They do not practice what they preach, is a challenge to all Christians about the quality of their worship and the witness of their faith. Christ invites us to profess what we say and do what we mean. All of us are in constant danger of not living up to our ideals. As leaders in a local community, if our actions speak louder than words, then our external actions must match our inner genuineness. 


