

# **Second Sunday of Advent**

John the Baptist was a prophet- a chosen messenger whose role was to prepare the way for God's entry among his people. The people came into the wilderness to hear him preach repentance and the announcement that the long-awaited day of salvation was about to dawn on them. Through his words he reprimanded the people for their loose lifestyles. The Baptist message was simple: Do penance, reform your lifestyles by prayer and fasting for the kingdom of God is at hand. His voice speaks to us across the ages and urges us to prepare a place for the Lord in our hearts.

Advent is an invitation to conversion and John the Baptist gives us some down-toearth advice on how to better our lives. He talks about filling in valleys of prejudice, levelling down mountains of pride and straightening out the crooked paths of injustice. We need to ask ourselves as to what areas of our lives need a complete turning around to allow God to come close to us. Advent is a time to make a fresh start. Preparing for God in our hearts is time-consuming and requires a lot of sacrifice. It may mean walking a new path.

The voice of John the Baptist reminds us that we have the task of announcing Christ to others. Through acts of kindness, honesty and faithfulness, our everyday lives are a message telling everyone that Christ is right here with us. Advent is the season that reminds us of a real spiritual homecoming by making the necessary preparations for the arrival of the Saviour into our lives.

Look, I am going to send my messenger before you; he will prepare your way.

A voice cries in the wilderness: Prepare a way for the Lord, make his paths straight, and so it was that John the Baptist appeared in the wilderness, proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins.

All Judaea and all the people of Jerusalem made

their way to him, and as they were baptised by him in the river Jordan they confessed their sins. John wore a garment of camel-skin, and he lived on locusts and wild honey. In the course of his preaching he said, 'Someone is following me,



someone who is more powerful than I am, and I am not fit to kneel down and undo the strap of his sandals. I have baptised you with water, but he will baptise you with the Holy Spirit.'
